

Mansfield raids net 2 suspects, drugs, guns

MANSFIELD — Two Detroit men were arrested on drug-related felonies during three raids Tuesday night.

The joint operation involved the METRICH Enforcement Unit; Allied Special Operations Response Team; Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco and Firearms; Richland County Sheriff's Department; and city and Ontario police.

A raid at 50 1/2 Rowland Ave. resulted in the arrest of Terrence Sudberry, 36, for drug abuse — a second-degree felony because he reportedly had more than 10 grams of crack. Authorities recovered crack, marijuana, drug paraphernalia and \$3,442 in cash.



Two Detroit men were arrested on drug-related felonies during three raids in Mansfield on Tuesday night.

Lenzie Carter, 19, was arrested at 5 Stoodt Court for possession of drugs and trafficking in marijuana. Police entered the residence and saw Carter lying on a couch, reportedly with a gun on the floor and a bag of Ecstasy under a cushion.

Carter tried to run out the back door but was caught by officers who'd formed a perimeter around the house.

In a third raid, police recovered three guns at 143 Stewart Ave. but made no arrests. The target of a shooting investigation was not there. METRICH Commander Lt. Dino Sgambellone declined to elaborate.
