

Monroeville man arrested during traffic stop for heroin possession

A 22-year-old Monroeville man was arrested during a traffic stop for allegedly having heroin, according to the Huron County Sheriff's Office. Nicholas Taylor, of 62 Monroe St., was charged with possession of heroin, according to Norwalk Municipal Court records.

Capt. Robert McLaughlin, who also serves as the commander of the Huron County Unit of the METRICH Drug Task Force, stopped Taylor's vehicle to arrest him on a contempt warrant issued by the Bowling Green Police Department, McLaughlin and a report said.

McLaughlin found suspected heroin in the vehicle as well as a tube believed to be used for inhaling heroin, Clifford and McLaughlin said. The suspected heroin and instrument were sent to a Mansfield crime laboratory to be analyzed.
