

2 arrested by WCSO in search warrant execution

The Wyandot County Sheriff's Office seized many drug-related items, as well as stolen property, after it executed a search warrant at 16753 Cherokee Street, Harpster, on Monday night.

The WCSO reportedly discovered a marijuana growing operation and stolen property at the residence.

Benjamin M. Gamble was arrested on undisclosed charges and a juvenile, Dylan S. Hill, no address given, was arrested for underage consumption.

The WCSO, a member of the METRICH drug task force, seized many items including a firearm, 17 marijuana plants, various cultivation items, 14 street signs, street barricade items, ATVs and snowmobiles with license plates removed or attempts to be removed and various other items.
