## **SEARCH WARRANT EXECUTED AT THE ENFERNO GENTLEMAN'S CLUB**

Sheriff Ron Shawber reported that officers from the Crawford County Sheriff's Office, Bucyrus Police Department, METRICH Enforcement Unit and the Ohio Investigative Unit – Liquor Control Division, executed a search warrant at The Enferno Gentleman's Club, 934 Lincoln Highway, Bucyrus. Large quantities of alcohol, \$856.00 cash, a small amount of marijuana and drug paraphernalia, along with items relating to illegal liquor sales and illegal operation of a sexually oriented business were seized. Two female dancers at the club, ages 21 and 29, were detained, processed and released pending review of filing charges by the Prosecutor's Office. This was the conclusion of an ongoing investigation by the Sheriff's Office and METRICH.
