

METRICH raids 2 homes, recovers heroin

MANSFIELD — The METRICH Enforcement Unit raided two homes simultaneously Wednesday night.

While some of the detectives, with support from the Allied Special Operations Response Team, went to 110 S. Foster St., others were at 475 Pennsylvania Ave. in Madison Township.

Authorities didn't search the Foster Street residence right away because of the presence of children, but they recovered 30 to 40 balloons of heroin at 475 Pennsylvania Ave.

In addition, the Richland County division of the Northern Ohio Violent Fugitives Task Force fanned out over the county to try to serve 44 people with drug-related indictments.
