## **MARMET SEARCH WARRANT**

On 03-18-2011 at 7:15pm the MARMET-METRICH Drug Task Force served a search warrant at 1060 North Main Street, Lot 48 Marion, Ohio. The task force was assisted by additional deputies of the sheriff's office. As a result of the search warrant detectives seized several hundred prescription pills including Xanax and Oxycodones. Several items of drug paraphernalia were seized along with a marijuana plant.

Arrested was James D. Tyler, 22 years of age of 1060 North Main Street, Lot 48 for Trafficking Drugs, Possession of Drugs, Drug Paraphernalia, and Cultivating Drugs. Also arrested was Richard T.S. Wilder, 24 years of age of 230 Pennsylvania Avenue Apartment C. Marion, Ohio for Drug Paraphernalia.

The drug task force received tips from citizens regarding this address. The MARMET-METRICH Drug Task Force is made up of detectives from both the Marion County Sheriff's Office and the Marion City Police Department.
