

Search of Mansfield bar results in 2 arrests, 6 charges

MANSFIELD -- Two people were arrested and dozens of bottles of alcohol were confiscated after authorities searched a Mansfield bar operating without a license.

The search was conducted Wednesday by METRICH Enforcement Unit agents and Mansfield police officers at That Won Place, 390 Orange St.

Ronald Durfee, 39, of 228 North Ford Road, was charged with two counts of operating a place where beer or intoxicating liquors are furnished without a permit and two counts of operating a place where liquor is furnished without a permit, both first-degree misdemeanors.

Amber Durfee, 31, of 75 Harker St., was charged with possession of marijuana and possession of drug paraphernalia, both first-degree misdemeanors.

Authorities seized from the business numerous cases of beer, 32 bottles of liquor and \$678 in cash.
