

Two arrested following investigation into armed robberies in Carey

On Tuesday, December 10, the Wyandot County Sheriff's Office was requested by the Carey Police Department to assist with an investigation involving an armed robbery in Carey. An 18 years-old pizza delivery man was robbed by two males wearing masks and armed with knives.

Approximately three hours later, a Shell Gas Station in Carey was entered and cash and merchandise was taken. Video footage confirmed that the same two suspects were involved in the armed robbery.

In the early hours of December 11, a search warrant was executed at 214 South Vance Street, Apt B, Carey. Andrew Conner was arrested and charged with Possession of Drugs. Additional charges are pending for Robbery, Breaking and Entering and Burglary.

Jordan Porter was located in Findlay, where he was arrested and charged with Breaking and Entering, Robbery and Burglary.

The arrest of these two individuals led to a search warrant at 116 Newhard, in Carey, where drugs, money and guns were removed. Kerry McKitrick was arrested and charged with Possession of Drugs. Several other felony charges are pending.

Other agencies assisting with the investigation were the Wyandot County Major Crimes, Wyandot County Prosecutor's Office, Upper Sandusky Police Department and the METRICH Enforcement Unit.
