

Bucyrus Police and METRICH Seize 77 grams of meth

The Bucyrus Police Department reported a very busy end of February where over 70 grams of Methamphetamine were seized.

On February 20th, Officer Jason Pennington conducted a traffic stop in the City of Bucyrus. An investigation led to the arrest for drug possession and the seizure of 10 grams of methamphetamine. Further investigation led to a search warrant, where an additional 14 grams of Methamphetamine was seized, as well as another arrest.



On February 25th, Officer Shane Cramer made a traffic stop in the City of Bucyrus of an individual from Holmes County. It was discovered that the individual was in possession of 53 grams of methamphetamine. Officers also learned that the meth was meant for distribution in the Bucyrus Area.

The two traffic stops resulted in the seizure of a combined 77 grams of methamphetamine.

The Bucyrus Police Department and the METRICH Enforcement Unit were involved in the investigation.
