

METRICH raid nets meth, suspected heroin, prescription pills, \$7,956

The METRICH Enforcement Unit seized meth, suspected heroin, numerous prescription drugs and \$7,956 in cash Monday during a search of 1174 W. Longview Ave.

METRICH Enforcement Unit detectives and the Mansfield Police Patrol section searched the residence as a result of citizen complaints which resulted in an investigation of Robert Hall, 55, on a charge of trafficking in drugs, according to a news release from METRICH.



During the search detectives seized approximately 12.5 grams of methamphetamine, 10.5 grams of suspected heroin and numerous prescription drugs. Also seized was \$7,956.00 in American currency believed to be the product of illegal activity.

Hall is being held at the Richland County Jail on drug trafficking charges and further charges will be presented to the Richland County Prosecutors Office.

"The METRICH Enforcement Unit will continue to seek those that pollute our streets with narcotics," METRICH Sgt. Steve Blust said. He encouraged all citizens to continue reporting suspected drug activity.
