

Three jailed following Findlay drug search

Three people were incarcerated following a drug search in the 100 block of Ely Avenue early Tuesday morning.

A press release from the Hancock METRICH Drug Task Force states that Jessica Lause, 33, and Dylan Skaggs, 30, both of 136 Ely Ave., and Shaun Eller, 41, of 820 Hurd Ave., were arrested and incarcerated on several outstanding warrants for various drug violations, drug trafficking indictments and a probation violation. The arrests came after METRICH and the Findlay Police Department Emergency Response Team executed a search warrant at 5:39 a.m. at 136 Ely Ave.

A search of the residence yielded approximately 1.56 pounds of methamphetamine and just over ½ pound of suspected Spice (synthetic marijuana), along with a small amount of cash, drug paraphernalia and items indicative of drug trafficking, the release states. Two firearms, including one reported stolen from a Findlay address, were recovered as well.

The three subjects are incarcerated at the Hancock County Justice Center.

The case is still under investigation. Additional charges of drug trafficking, having weapons under disability and receiving stolen property are expected once the investigation is complete, the report states.
