

Two arrested following drug raids in Upper Sandusky, Sycamore

Two people were arrested Wednesday following the execution of three drug related residential search warrants in Wyandot County.

At approximately 7:30 a.m., the Wyandot County Sheriff's Office Special Response Team (SRT) began serving the warrants at 1049 N. Warpole St., Lot #37, and 315 N. Eighth Street in Upper Sandusky. A third search warrant was served at 4491 State Route 67 in Sycamore.



44-year-old Jennifer E. Glass, of Upper Sandusky, and 45-year-old Chad Rogers, also of Upper Sandusky, were arrested and charged with possession of methamphetamine.

Additionally, a male and female were detained at 4491 State Route 67 in Sycamore as part of the investigation. Charges are expected on those individuals after additional investigation, according to police.

Methamphetamine, a firearm, and cash were seized during the execution of the search warrants, the Wyandot County Sheriff's Office said in a news release.
