

METRICH/Crawford County sheriff's raid nets drugs, cash and two arrests

Deputies from the Crawford County Sheriff's Office and the METRICH Enforcement Unit seized suspected drugs, cash, and drug paraphernalia and made two arrests on Friday at 912 Sherman St.

Law enforcement officials served a narcotic search warrant at the conclusion of an investigation into illegal narcotics being used and sold from the property.

Arrested was Amanda L. Hill, 42, and Robert G. Bowersock, 50, according to the Crawford County Sheriff's Office.



Deputies seized suspected methamphetamines, psilocybin mushrooms, marijuana, currency, prescription medication and drug paraphernalia, according to a news release from the sheriff's office.

Both individuals were taken to the Crawford County Justice Center. Bowersock was later released. Reports will be forwarded to the Crawford County Prosecutor's Office for consideration of charges, the sheriff's office said.

This case is still being investigated by the detectives from the sheriff's office.
