

Arlington house the target of drug raid

An Arlington man was arrested after a narcotic search warrant was executed Tuesday night in the 100 block of South Cumberland Street, Arlington.

A release from the Hancock METRICH Enforcement Unit states Shane Lively Sr., 38, of 119 S. Cumberland St., was arrested and is incarcerated at the Hancock County Justice Center following the 11:30 p.m. search warrant raid.

The news release said the Drug Task Force, assisted by the Hancock County Special Response Team, found suspected methamphetamine, suspected prescription pills and drug paraphernalia. Multiple items indicative of drug trafficking were also located.

Lively is charged with two counts of trafficking in drugs, a felony in the 5th degree, according to the release.

Additional charges of drug trafficking in a school zone and possession of drugs are expected at the conclusion of this investigation, the release states.
