

2 people face felony drug charges in Hancock County

Two people are facing drug-related felony charges in Hancock County after a police raid early Friday morning.

The Hancock County METRICH Drug Task Force, assisted by the Findlay Police Department's Emergency Response Team, executed a search warrant at 5:36 a.m. in the 500 block of Clinton Court, according to a news release. The search yielded crack cocaine, fentanyl, drug paraphernalia, a large amount of cash, and items indicative of drug trafficking.

Porshia L. Frisbie, 29, and Jeffrey L. Williams, 42, both of the Clinton Court address, were arrested and booked into the Hancock County Justice Center. They were both charged with one count of possession of fentanyl, a second-degree felony, and one count of possession of crack cocaine, a third-degree felony.

An investigation is ongoing and additional charges are expected, according to police.
