

Raids yield guns, meth at 2 local homes

The Wyandot County Major Crimes Unit and the METRICH Enforcement Unit executed two search warrants in the county Monday.

A release states the Wyandot County Sheriff's Office executed a search of 14391 Ohio 294 in Upper Sandusky, at the residence of Jeremy D. Clark and Kacy J. Swan.

Discovered at the scene were several firearms and suspected methamphetamine. Charges are expected to include possession of methamphetamine, having weapons under disability and tampering with evidence.



The Sheriff also worked with the Carey Police Department at 108 ½ S. Vance St. in Carey, identified as the residence of Alex and Michael Naeyaert. Officers recovered suspected methamphetamine, prescription pills, a handgun, currency, drug paraphernalia and other items associated with drug trafficking. Charges are expected to include trafficking in methamphetamine, aggravated possession of drugs and having weapons under disability.



Together, the release states, the searches came up with approximately a half pound of seized methamphetamine. Other suspected illegal narcotics were also taken at the scene.

Reports from both searches will be sent to the Wyandot County prosecutor for charges.
