

Search warrant at Findlay home leads to drug, gun seizure and arrest

A narcotics search warrant executed at a Findlay home led to the seizure of drugs, cash and firearms and the arrest of a 42-year-old man, according to law enforcement officials.

The Hancock County METRICH Drug Task Force, assisted by the Findlay Police Department and the Hancock County Sheriff's Office, served the warrant around 6:42 p.m. on Wednesday at a residence in the 1600 block of Burson Drive.

Authorities said they seized 215 grams of suspected cocaine, \$15,501 in cash, six firearms and multiple items believed to be connected to drug trafficking. A 2021 Chevrolet 1500 pickup truck was also seized during the search.

Skylar Johnson, 42, who was listed as residing at the address, was arrested and taken to the Hancock County Justice Center.

Johnson was charged with possession of drugs, a first-degree felony; trafficking in drugs, first- and third-degree felonies; and having weapons under disability, a third-degree felony. Authorities said additional charges related to drug trafficking and possession are expected as the investigation continues.

The case remains under investigation.
